Filling out raffle ticket stubs information

Please remember that using address labels on raffle ticket entries is not always permitted, so be sure to check the rules before applying them. Even when labels are allowed, it is generally better not to use them at all. Many labels do not fit properly inside the ticket space, and when they hang over the edges or wrap around the sides, they tend to peel off. Once loose, they can stick to other tickets, cause them to cling together, and create a messy—and potentially unfair—situation during the drawing. This not only slows down the process but can raise concerns about the integrity of the raffle.

Consider purchasing a small personalized stamp with your name, address, and phone number. A stamp is quick, clean, easy to read, and avoids all the issues that labels can cause. Using a stamp helps keep the raffle fair, organized, and efficient for everyone involved.

When people know what's happening they show up, they get involved, they take ownership of the mission.

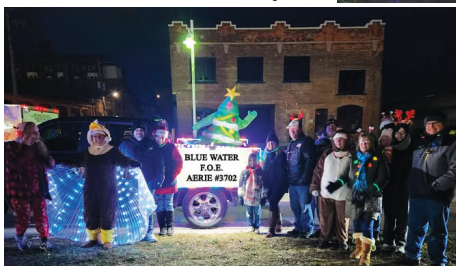

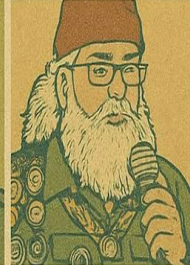
