# Mother's Day and the role of the Fraternal Order of Eagles

Mother's Day is often credited to Anna Jarvis, but members of the Fraternal Order of Eagles recognize the important role played by Frank E. Hering in establishing the holiday.

On February 7, 1904, Hering made a public appeal for a national day dedicated to honoring mothers everywhere. A decade later, Woodrow Wilson signed a proclamation officially designating the second Sunday in May as

Mother's Day, with May 10, 1914, observed as the first national celebration.

Hering, a faculty member at University of Notre Dame, was inspired after seeing students preparing postcards to send home to their mothers. While serving as Grand Worthy President of the Eagles in 1909 and 1911, he used his leadership role to spread the idea nationwide, building strong support throughout the organization.

Today, more than a century later, the Fraternal Order of Eagles continues to take pride in its role in promoting Mother's Day. In 1925, the American War Mothers honored Hering by introducing him as the "Father of Mother's Day" before members of Congress at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, helping to cement both his legacy—and that of the Eagles—in the history of the holiday.


